In the past, many scholars have resided at UNM area community housing, only 5 miles from Kirtland AFB. Staying in these communities promotes friendships, social connections for down-time and activities, carpool opportunities, and builds a community "hub" for the internship program that we would like to encourage. Please note that move in/move out dates for community housing may differ

from your internship start/end dates, requiring that you find alternative lodging for a short time at the start or end of your internship. Contact the leasing agents directly to inquire about early arrival or extended stay dates.


Questions to consider during the housing search:

- Does the property offer short-term leases? Pay attention to "move-in" and "move-out" dates.
- Pay attention to requirements to notify management of your move-out date don't assume they just know. If you don't notify them appropriately, you could be responsible for another month's rent.
- What are the lease terms for the property?
- What is the surrounding community like (i.e., neighborhood, security issues, transportation access, etc.)?
- Will you need a furnished residence?
- How far is the commute to your worksite?
- What amenities are available at the property?
- Are utilities included in rent costs or do they need to be set up separately?
- What is the total cost? Are there any additional fees or deposits?
